GUIDANCE FOR OVERSEAS EDUCATON BY IDP



They were taught about the various procedures and precautions along with proper methods of how to apply injections to patients. This session provided training in the knowledge, skills, and safety considerations for properly giving injections by various routes. Techniques to reduce pain while giving intramuscular injections were also taught by the demonstrator. It was explained that Unsafe injection practices can have a significant impact on patient outcomes such as nerve damage, abscesses, and pain, resulting in potential litigation. Students learned about syringes, injections, and IV abuse. This hands-on practical training session blended learning course allowed participants to demonstrate theoretical and practical competencies within a classroom environment. This session is intended to provide a broad understanding of injection techniques and routes and common injectable medication. Learning about injections is not just for doctors or physicians but also for the common man and learning this skill gives an edge to a pharmacy student. This also helps them as an extracurricular skill that can be used while working at a clinical pharmacy.






